Initiatives at EU / Policy making Levels for sectoral upskilling / reskilling of employees?

Networking hub

support in finding partners and first meetings of the partnerships; linking with existing EU tools, e.g. Europass, Skills Panorama, EURES and European Network of Public Employment Services; promotion of the activities of the Pact members.

Knowledge hub

webinars, seminars peer learning activities; updates on EU policies and instruments; information on projects, tools instruments and best practices

Guidance and resources hub

access to information on relevant EU funding; guidance to identify financial possibilities; facilitation of exchange between the Pact members and national/regional authorities

Erasmus+

Tourism organisations wanting to participate in Erasmus+ may engage in a number of development and networking activities in the fields of academic and vocational training, schools, adult learning, youth and European sport events

Digital Europe Programme

With a planned overall budget of €7.5 billion (in current prices), the Digital Europe Programme will shape and support the digital transformation of Europe's society and economy, with the ultimate goal of supporting the strategic autonomy of the EU single market

European Social Fund Plus (ESF+)

The ESF+ is a key financial instrument in implementing the European Pillar of Social Rights, supporting jobs and skills, and creating a fair and socially inclusive society. It provides much-needed resources to EU countries for the recovery of our societies and economies after the coronavirus crisis

Recovery and Resilience Facility

*Centrepiece of Europe's recovery plan, **NextGenerationEU**. It aims to mitigate the economic and social impact of the COVID-19 crisis and make European economies and societies more sustainable, resilient and better prepared for the challenges and opportunities of the green and digital transitions.*
